
REPROUNION LEADS THE WAY IN OVERCOMING INFERTILITY NOW AND IN THE FUTURE!

With an extensive experience in cross-border collaborations, and as the only organization that actively works to gather Swedish and Danish life science, MVA has been able to contribute significantly to the project, including being one of the main drivers in the development phase as well as in the process of getting funding raised for the ReproUnion project.
