## **Biography**

William Wade is Professor of Oral Microbiology at Queen Mary University of London and Honorary Senior Research Investigator at the Forsyth Institute, Cambridge, USA. He graduated in Microbiology at the University of East Anglia in 1978 and obtained a PhD from the University of Wales, Cardiff.

He took up a Lectureship in Cardiff in 1987, followed by a Senior Lectureship at the University of Bristol in 1993. In 1996 he was appointed Professor of Oral Microbiology at King's College London.

His current research interests include the molecular characterisation of the human microbiome in health and disease, the cultivation of previously uncultured bacteria and the development and evaluation of antimicrobials and probiotics for the prevention and treatment of oral diseases.
