**Biography**

Thomas Nagy holds a B.Sc. in Chemical Engineering from the Technical University of Denmark and is a graduate of the Wharton School of Business AMP program.

Thomas joined the Novo Nordisk Foundation in the fall of 2016 leading a biomedical and biotech innovation Initiative with the goal of bridging research and innovation into new life science companies, growth and jobs in Denmark. The Board of the Novo Nordisk Foundation approved the project proposal in December 2017 with a three-year implementation grant of 392 million DKK and the BioInnovation Institute is now in the implementation phase.

Thomas Nagy serves on boards and as advisor in several companies within the life science space and is a mentor with the NOME initiative in Scandinavia and with IndieBio in San Francisco.

Thomas Nagy has spent most of his prior career with Novozymes holding various managerial and technical positions in Denmark and abroad, such as Executive Vice President of Supply Operations or Executive Vice President of Stakeholder Relations and President of Novozymes North America Inc. from 2004 - 2008
